

## **SA-P-5404 –ELECTRONICS POLICY**

The Board of FTAA-MT believes the use of electronic devices with photographic, audio, video, and/or text messaging capability creates the potential for violations of privacy as well as threats to testing/examination security.

In order to ensure examination security and the privacy of individuals, the Board prohibits the use of such devices as follows:

1. A.) During any test, examination, or in any situation with the potential for plagiarism or cheating;
2. B.) In any bathroom, locker room, dressing room or other areas (both private and public) where individuals have an expectation of privacy.
3. C.) Using them in any manner that interferes with, or is disruptive of, the educational process or invades the privacy of any student(s), employee(s), volunteer(s) or visitor(s).

The principal shall create regulations that prohibit on-campus and dormitory use of electronics and impose discipline for violations of this policy pursuant to the Code of Conduct or Discipline Matrix.
