

## **SA-P-5450 – RESIDENTIAL LIFE POLICY**

The Board of Fei Tian Academy of the Arts-Middletown (FTAA-MT) is committed to guiding students in their development as individuals, encouraging self-discipline, and fostering respect for the rights and privileges of others. Policies, rules, and regulations provide dormitory residents with some structure in their choices.

The success of a residential community such as ours requires a collaborative effort between the residential life staff and residents. It is important for all residents to remember that in choosing FTAA-MT, you have agreed to be a part of this community and to play a part in making it a desirable living environment for all residents. Our concern is to help you learn to live, work, and communicate with others and to manage a shared living environment in ways that will provide a safe, healthy, balanced atmosphere (i.e. study, socialize, sleep, and play).

Residents must learn to appreciate how much they depend on each other in these community living spaces and why it is so important that they respect each other's rights and privileges. They will also see how their personal contributions will have the strongest impact on their residential experience. The residential life staff is here to guide them in these efforts.

The policies for Residential Life are a comprehensive list of the various rules and expectations of students who choose to live in Campus Housing. All students are held to a high moral standard of responsibility for their property and that of others. The Dorm Rules and Fire Drill Procedure include procedures to follow in case of damages or emergencies as well as what is and is not permitted in the Campus Dormitory, and much more information to ensure students are well informed of their expectations for living on campus
